The Water Culture Museum of North China University of Water Resources and Electric Power officially opened in March 2024.

The museum has two floors, with an indoor exhibition area of about 1800 square meters, divided into four core exhibition halls.

Through photo exhibitions, video playback, interactive viewing, and other functions, the museum explains in an engaging way the glorious history of Chinese water conservancy for more than 5000 years.

It is currently the only immersive experiential "water culture museum" in Chinese universities.

The Yellow River Water Conservancy Culture Museum of the Hetao Irrigation District, Inner Mongolia, opened in November 2013.

Its mission is to promote the cultural heritage of Yellow River water conservancy, the historical evolution of the Hetao Irrigation District, and the pioneering achievements in water management.

The museum spans an exhibition area of 3,500 square metres, divided into three thematic sections.

The exhibition space displays more than 800 artefacts and over 1,000 sets of historical water conservancy texts, employing extensive multimedia technology to vividly recreate historical scenes.

The SAGUAPAC Cultural Centre aims to promote the knowledge of the urban water cycle, starting with the drinking water supply service provided by the SAGUAPAC cooperative.

It has a recording studio, a theatre stage and museum pieces from the first cooperative's actions for the potable water service (taps, measurers, administration tools, panels).

Its facilities host meetings and conferences with school students and universities, as well as guided tours of structures such as water pumping stations and wastewater treatment plants.

The Columban Way Cultural Route connects towns and regions linked to the historical journey of Columbanus (also known as Columban), who left Ireland in 590 and travelled across several European countries over a period of 25 years, reaching Italy (specifically in Bobbio, Emilia Romagna region, headquarters of the association).

The Columban Way, reconstructed on the basis of historical sources, it's one of the longest cultural routes in Europe (approximately 5,300 km), crossing multiple regions in Ireland, UK, France, Luxemburg, Germany, Switzerland, Austria, Liechtenstein and Italy.

The Columban Path promotes the discovery of a shared European legacy, shaped by knowledge exchange and the preservation of cultural practices.
