

Jalapão State Park, Brazil

I. Japanese Lagoon

The lagoon has crystal clear waters, with colors ranging from green to turquoise. Cooling off there is highly recommended, as is enjoying the perfect visibility (and the fishes).

II. Morro da Pedra Furada

The rock formation embedded in the Cerrado creates a unique panorama and, at the same time, makes us feel the grandeur of what is around us. Do you want to intensify the effect of this scenario sculpted by climate and time? So try to visit it around sunset time.

III. Sussuapara Canyon

Composed of natural walls formed into a path and surrounded by vegetation. There, water slides through the cracks continuously and a waterfall is found at the bottom.

IV. Rio Novo Quilombola Community and Prainha do Rio Novo

In the Rio Novo Quilombola Community you can even have lunch and do community-based tourism and get in touch with the human and social side of Jalapão, which is as deep as the natural one.

V. Jalapão Dunes

The Jalapão Dunes, also known as an indescribable landscape, present a stunning panorama that harmoniously melds lush green vegetation with pristine lakes scattered amidst majestic golden sand dunes.

VI. Serra do Espírito Santo and Morro do Jacurutu

A trail to admire the starry sky or watch the sunrise, climbing the Serra do Espírito Santo. The difficulty of the trail is considered medium to high. Up there, dawn and a 360° angle open the morning.

VII. Formiga Waterfall

Cachoeira da Formiga has emerald green waters and a pleasant temperature: everything about it is impressive! Which makes it impossible to not lose track of time between one dive and another.

VIII. Fervedouro of Macaúbas and Fervedouro Bela Vista

These natural pools are classified as exfiltration points for water from deep aquifers, making it impossible to reach the bottom. Jalapão offers over a dozen boiling sites that can be visited, each with unique sizes, colors, and intensities.

IX. Prata Quilombola Community

The Prata Quilombola Community provides an excellent opportunity to gain a more comprehensive understanding of the culture, traditions, and art of the local residents. In addition to enjoying a delightful lunch in the community, visitors also have the opportunity to purchase exquisite golden grass crafts.

X. Araras Waterfall

Araras Waterfall works really well for a farewell to the waters of Jalapão. It's that kind of bucolic place capable of recharging your energy.
