FEES

Attendance fees are foreseen for all participants that are not WAMU-NET members (€ 250 for regular fee, and € 50 for LICs).

One person from each water museum/member of WAMU-NET can participate for free. Each 2nd, 3rd, 4th (and so on) person can participate with a 50% discount on the regular fee (125 euros for regular fee; 25 euros for LICs).

PRE-REGISTRATION, ADMISSION & REGISTRATION

How to pre-register: in order to pre-register, potential attendees have to fill in the questionnaire and send a short CV and a letter of motivation to Sara Luchetta (sara.luchetta@unive.it)

Admission: admissions will be based on the CV and the motivation letter.

Registration: attendees will have to register by paying the fee (if due) and by filling in the registration form. The link to the registration form will be sent after admission.

ATTENDANCE CERTIFICATE

A **certificate of attendance** will be issued at the end of the training course by the UNESCO Chair based at the University of Venice. In order to receive the certificate, participants must attend at least **9 webinars out of 12** (about 80% attendance).
